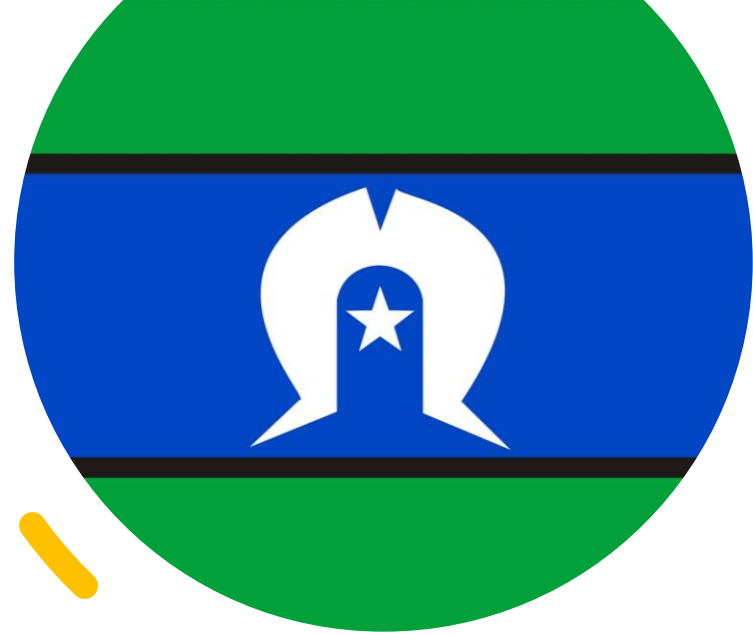

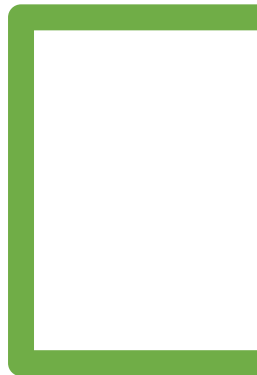

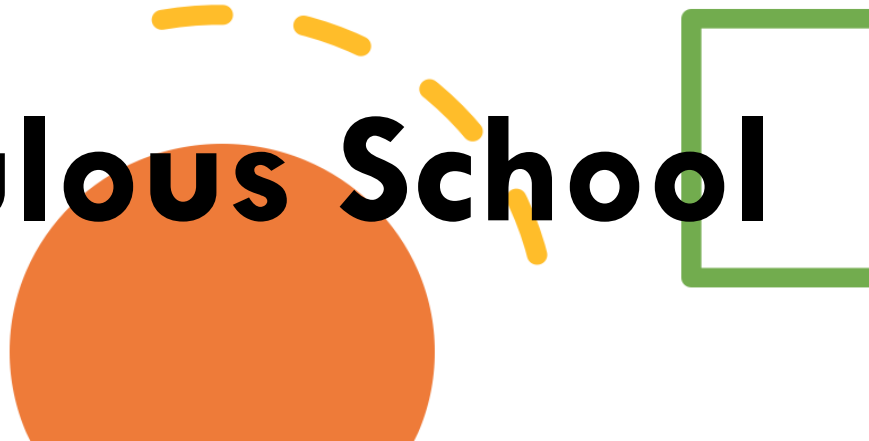

Academic Skills

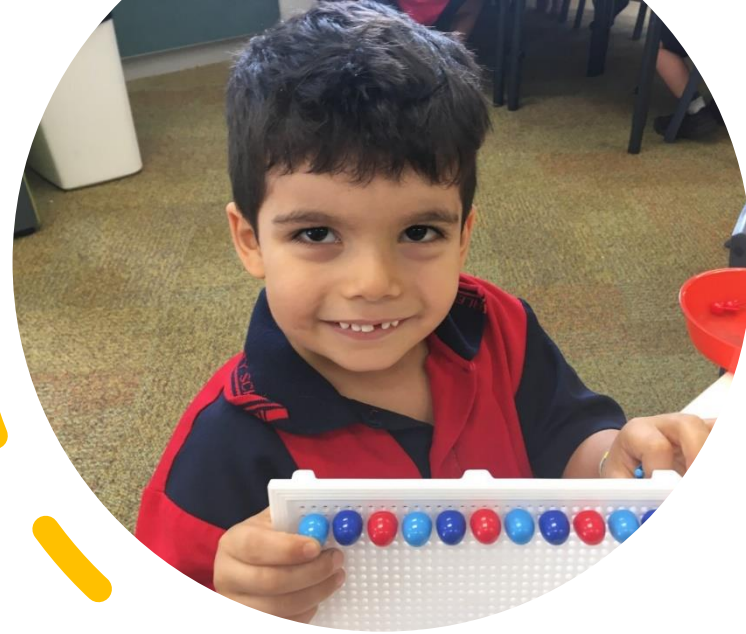
- Look at books for enjoyment

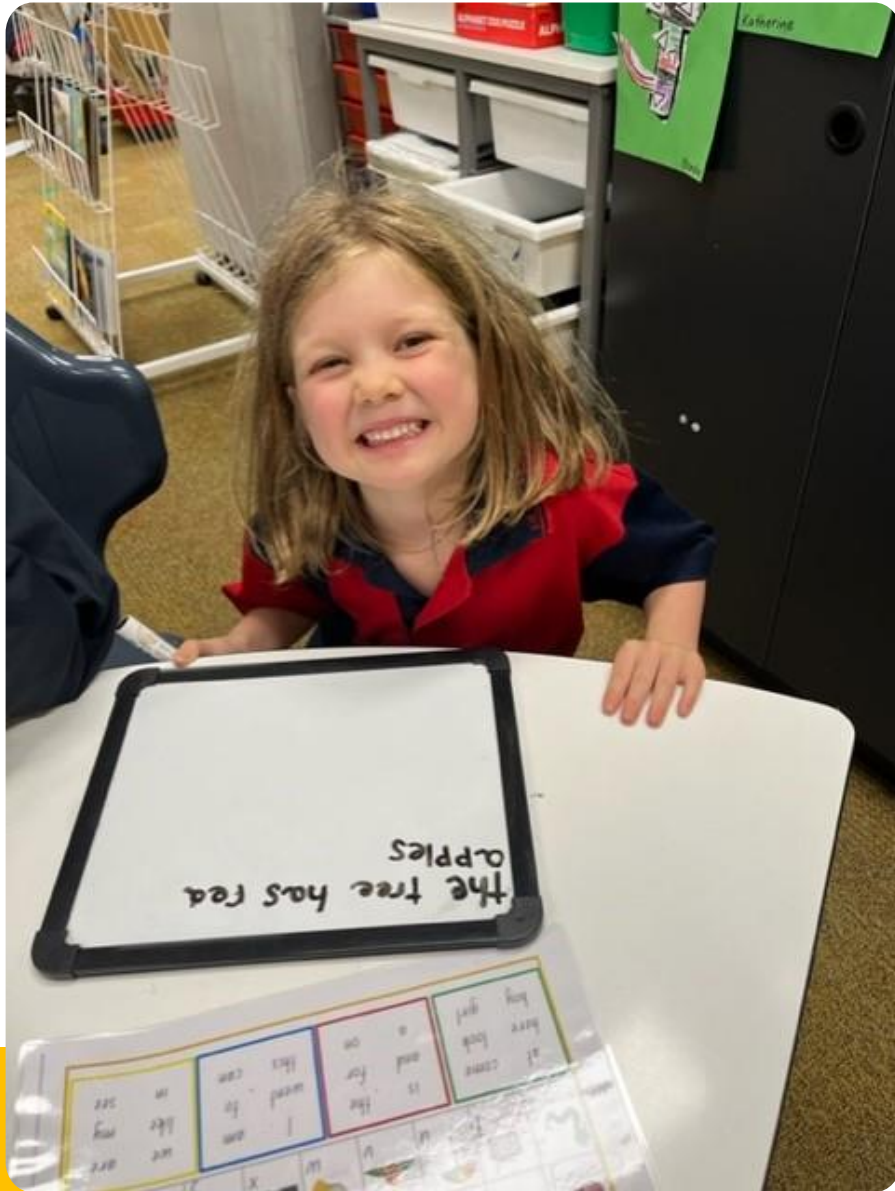
From pregnancy until your child is 5 years of age, the brain develops rapidly and they learn faster than at any other time.

Common Questions

How many children in each class?

- About 20

How many classes?

- Usually 4 or 5

How many teachers?

- Each class has 1 teacher. Sometimes teachers may job-share, so 2 teachers may share a class.

Can my child enrol if we live out-of-area?

- You can apply using an out-of-area application form. We accept very few out-of-area applications and only for compelling reasons. You should enrol at your local school as a backup in case your application is not successful.

Do you cater for students with additional learning and support needs?

- Yes, absolutely! Please let us know your child's needs as soon as possible so we can work together to support them to have a positive, happy and fun start to school!
