Investing in our schools

The NSW Government is investing \$6.7 billion over four years to deliver more than 190 new and upgraded schools to support communities across NSW. In addition, a record \$1.3 billion is being spent on school maintenance over five years. This is the largest investment in public education infrastructure in the history of NSW.

The NSW Department of Education is committed to delivering new and upgraded schools for communities across New South Wales. The delivery of these important projects is essential to the future learning needs of our students and supports growth in the local economy.

Alexandria Park Community School

The school is being redeveloped to cater for increasing student enrolments from Kindergarten to Year 12. At completion the project will deliver new permanent learning spaces, special education learning spaces, and special high school program rooms. It will also provide new core facilities such as an administration area, hall, library, gymnasium, sports courts and outdoor play spaces.

Progress summary

Phase 1 of the redevelopment is on schedule and progressing well. The structural works are complete and the final floor slab was poured in the first week of April.

Walls and services fit-out are underway across all buildings. The cladding and facades have progressed and scaffold will be coming down over the coming months.

Term 1 holiday works consist of ongoing fit out of the new school and installing the cladding and façade.
