Alexandria Park Community School

The overall masterplan for Alexandria Park Community School will allow for 1000 primary students and up to 1200 secondary students.

Stage 1 of the redevelopment is progressing well. It will deliver high quality facilities for 1,000 primary students and 850 secondary students plus staff. We will develop additional learning spaces in future Stage 2 works.

The project provides new permanent learning spaces, special education learning spaces, special program rooms (high school) for subjects including visual and performing arts, science, woodwork and new facilities including an administration area, hall, library, gymnasium, multiple sports courts and play spaces.

Progress summary

Phase I has been completed and is operational.

Phase 2 is now under construction with a target to complete works by early 2022.

Next Steps

- Removal of demountable buildings
- Excavation works in preparation for commencement of Phase 2 works.

Summer school holiday construction works

During the Term 4 2020 school holidays, construction will continue at Alexandria Park Community School after school finishes for the year on 18 December 2020.

The site will be closed from 25 December 2020 until 3 January 2021.

Works will resume on Monday 4 January 2021 and continue through the school holidays.

Monday to Friday construction works will be from 7.00am to 6.00pm.

Saturday works during the school holidays may go from 8.00am till 1.00pm. Work will not take place on Sundays.

Frequently asked questions

What works will take place during the school holidays?

Although Phase 1 of Alexandria Park Community School is complete and operational the school grounds will continue with site establishment in preparation for commencement of Phase 2 works. Temporary working sheds and toilet facilities will be installed.

Demolition of the temporary school facilities that currently occupy this area of the school site will continue until completion. Excavation works are part of this work.

What steps will be taken to control noise and dust from construction works taking place in the school holidays?

Noise and dust control measures will be implemented in accordance with planning approval requirements. Hoarding, secure fencing and shade cloth have been erected to reduce noise and dust impacts on the school and local residents. Dust from construction works will be hosed down as required.

What safety measures are in place?

Health and safety is our highest priority. We will be working collaboratively with the school community and neighbours to ensure that construction works will be scheduled and managed to minimise impacts to the community where possible.

Neighbours who may be potentially impacted by construction works, including any work conducted outside of approved hours, will receive a works notification providing advance notice.
