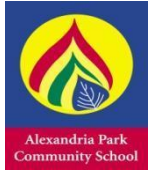


Excursion Notification Form

Year 7 Swimming Program 2021

Dear Parent / Caregiver,

This term Alexandria Park Community School will run a specialised sport swimming program for all year 7 students. The swimming program is compulsory for all students as it addresses Stage 4 PDHPE curriculum outcomes in relation to aquatics.

Students will be provided the opportunity to explore complex and challenging movement activities focusing on the fundamental movement skills of swimming. The program will be administered by qualified swimming instructors who have created a program that is age appropriate and will be customised to a range of swimming abilities; beginner, intermediate, and advanced.

The program will take place every Monday starting from Monday the 8th until Monday the 29th of March, during sport lessons. The school will provide bus transportation to and from the venue, leaving school premises by 12:15pm and arriving back at 2:40pm. Please note that the Department of Education policy states that face masks are compulsory on school-organised transport, hence your child will be required to provide and wear their own face mask.

As is normal procedure, student behaviour is expected to be of the highest quality and students should attend the day in the knowledge that they are representing our school.

Purpose of the excursion:	Satisfy PDHPE curriculum aquatics requirements.

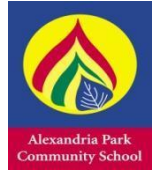
