Labelling

All items baked need to be labelled with the item name, the date on which it was baked, whether it is fresh or frozen, and a list of ALL ingredients. If you prepare the product yourself, you will know what is in it. If you have used a packet mix, write the ingredients from the packet on your label. Remember to include any other ingredients you may have added, such as eggs.

You can deliver your goodies to the school office between 12:00pm and 3:30pm on Tuesday 12th of December (day before) or the morning of the PBL carnival, 13th December between 8:00am and 9:00am.
