Learning at Home online with Google Classroom

Google classroom will be the primary platform for online learning. You will find all the Google Classroom Codes for each class on the last pages of this document. Please support your child in ensuring they have entered the appropriate Google Classroom for each of their classes. There is also a quick reference guide on how to access the Student Portal and Google Classroom.

Each year group will also have a dedicated classroom for student wellbeing and positive behaviour for learning which will be administered by the Year Adviser. Students should join their relevant year group also.

International students also have a dedicated classroom managed by the International Student Coordinator. These students will receive an invitation to this online resource via their school email.

Learning at Home with paper copies of classwork

For students who do not have access to the internet and a device, teachers are producing the classroom work in paper form. Units of classwork are stored at the High school Administration Office. If you need to access paper copies of school work please let us know by contacting the school and provide your child's name and year group. This work can be collected or sent home. All packages are sent with a reply paid envelope. It is important that this work is returned to the school.

Processes around marking and feedback for work submitted

Guidance and feedback relevant to each cohort and subject area will be provided by our teachers. Feedback will be provided, as appropriately and timely as possible, online or on paper copies. When school resumes more detailed feedback will be provided to the students.

Assessment tasks

As far as possible, teachers will adhere to the assessment schedules given to students earlier this year and in the curriculum booklets posted on the schools' website. However, as flexible learning is different to face to face learning, some adaptations or postponements are inevitable. Teachers in these circumstances will be communicating the changes to our students.

All Year 7 - 12 assessment tasks will be accessible via Google Classroom or will be posted via the mail to students. Online tasks will be submitted via Google Classroom. Those posted have a reply paid envelope which is to be sent back to the school by the due date.

Year 11 and 12 assessment tasks will follow the advice from NESA.

Processes for contacting teachers

Teachers may be contacted by students or by parents through a private post on Google Classroom. In addition, parents can also contact classroom teachers, Head Teachers or the Deputy Principal via email to the school's email address, alexparkcs-c.school@det.nsw.edu.au with the teachers' name in the subject. The email will then be forwarded to the appropriate person. Alternatively, you can call the school on 9698 1967.

Technical support

For technical support please call or email the school as above and outline the issue you are having. Your query will be forwarded to the Technical Support Officer.

Expectations of High School Students

Students log into the Google Classroom for each of their subjects. Refer to the Google Classroom Codes on the last pages of this document.

Students engage in learning activities posted on each subject's Google Classroom.

Students can contact their teacher through Google Classroom, email or by phoning the school if they need support to complete the tasks.

Students can contact their Year Adviser via calling the school, email or a private post on the Year Group Wellbeing Google Classroom if they are experiencing any wellbeing issues or have concerns for their friends.

Students interact on Google Classroom safely and respectfully.

Students completing the paper packages of classwork may contact their teacher by calling the school or emailing as above. They will complete the classwork and return it to their teacher in the reply paid envelope supplied.

YOUR MIND

- . Wake up with enough time to get ready and have breakfast before 8.40am check in.
- · Say good morning to your house-mates.
- At 8.40am login to Google Classrooms or take out your Learning from Home package and know what
 you need to do for the day. Experiencing problems? Post a question on Stream or call the school.
- · Write a To Do list and tick off activities as you do them.

YOUR SPACE

- Your learning space should be tidy, comfortable and as quiet as possible.
- Be respectful of shared spaces if other family members are learning or working from home.



YOUR CLOTHING

- · Dress in neat, casual clothes.
- Do not wear pyjamas.

YOUR EQUIPMENT

- Have your device charged and logged in; have a pen and notepaper for brainstorming & working out OR have your Learning from Home package, pens and notebook ready.
- · Use headphones if possible.
- Remove all distractions while you are learning especially social media. Apps for your phone such as Forest or Cold Turkey can help you.

YOUR RESPECTFUL LEARNING

- Be respectful and appropriate in your language online or in the school classroom.
- If you are invited to a Google Hangout Meet, turn off your microphone until required. Ask a question by using the Chat function.
- Turn your phone to silent and use the Forest or Cold Turkey app to avoid distraction.

YOUR HEALTH

- · Drink at least 2L of water per day
- Take breaks every 45-60 minutes by getting up out of your chair and walking around - do arm swings, neck & shoulder rolls, step outside into the fresh air.
- Have recess and lunch at similar times each day. Eat healthy food - try lots of different coloured foods.
- Engage in some exercise each day 30 minutes of cardio or dynamic stretching is a good place to start.
- · Practise mindfulness at least once a day.

YOUR TIME

- · Manage your time use it for learning.
- Submit the work listed in 'Assignments' in your Google Classroom or return your fortnightly Home Learning package to APCS.
- Spend time revising any items you don't understand and ask questions (you can ask yourself questions; post a question on Google Classroom or you can contact your teacher.

- Teachers may instruct you to use other apps in the Google Suite or online activities. Please follow their directions.
- You might also be asked to use apps such as Zoom, Please follow the teacher's directions.


Access Online Learning & School Emails

- If you need to ask your teachers a question or get a 'classcode' for online learning you can email your teacher


Accessing your emails

• Go to: https://education.nsw.gov.au/ and click log in, student log in on the top right hand side




Enter your student log in details

• Enter the log in details that you would use to sign into the school computers or school wifi




Student portal home page


• From your student portal home page you can access your emails
