Alexandria Park Community School welcomes **AFL Auskick and Superkick** to the school for students in Years K-6 to begin or continue their AFL journey.

AFL Auskick and Superkick gives your child an opportunity to get active and learn the skills of the game, including kicking, catching and teamwork.

Available to students in Years K-6, it will run for 4 weeks this term, and all equipment will be provided.

The Auskick program is for students from 4-7 years old, and the Superkick program is for students 8-12 years old.

DATES: Sessions will run each TUESDAY between 3 June and 24 June

TIMES: Sessions begin at 3:15 and finish at 4:15 pm.

LOCATION: Each group will be taken to the Getiela field to work with the AFL coaches.

COST: The 4-week program will cost **\$50.** Students will also receive an AFL goodies pack including a ball, pump and carry bag.
